General student expectations:

- Arts and academics are equally important. Students should keep up with their academic subjects to be able to perform in their art.
- Complete all assignments on time.

Interactive Notebooks:

Agenda Mate:

Homework:

Canvas:

Students should check Canvas daily for assignments, announcements, etc.

PowerSchool:
