**A Note about Volunteer Hours:** All CCA families are required to earn 18 volunteer hours per family, per year. If you have a sibling at another magnet school, the total hours are split between the two schools. When volunteering in person, you must sign in and out on the Volunteer Sign In sheet. When donating items, your student's name and grade must be on the Record of Magnet School Parent Service Hours form, or on the receipt. Volunteer hours are logged on a weekly basis. An updated total of hours will be posted on your student's Quarterly Report Card. If you have more than one student attending CCA, the total hours will be posted on the eldest student's report card.
