Thanks to everyone for making the quick pivot to remote learning last week. We have one more day of remote learning on Monday and then will be back in person on Tuesday. Please remind your students that they should be on Zoom for all 4 classes (we will not have a DS class on Monday, so they will have a full hour for lunch). We found that some students did not attend 4th block last week.

Thanks, also, for your excellent communication around positive Covid cases. Please continue to communicate with me when you have a positive case in the home, your child has a covid exposure, or when your child tests positive. Our cases dropped significantly over the past four days, with ten positive cases and two household contacts. I am optimistic that cases may continue to decrease if we are all vigilant about keeping kids at home when sick, mask wearing, and quick communication (and contact tracing) when there is a positive case.

In other news, we are proud to share that CCA's acting teacher, Magge Hudgins, is performing in *Alabama Story* at the Chattanooga Theater Center. We are so proud of her, and we encourage you to attend!
