Important Updates and Student Opportunities.

Summer Arts Institute - The Summer Arts Institute is now open to high school students in grades 9-11 currently. Please be advised, if your student has not completed the 10th grade (by the start of the Summer), they do not qualify for the Dual Enrollment Grant through the state of Tennessee, so the course would have to be paid out of pocket. The only other requirement is that the student must have a minimum 2.8 GPA. If you have registered your student for the Institute, please plan to attend a meeting at CCA on March 8 at 5:30 p.m. At this meeting, we will walk you through the registration and scholarship process.
