## From the Principal

**Eclipse on Monday:** Due to our many competing priorities and district safety requirements, we decided to not take students out for the eclipse. All students will be inside on Monday afternoon. The Coast to Coast College Fair is coming to Chattanooga on April 11 at the Chattanooga Convention Center. Sponsored by Baylor, GPS, McCallie, and St. Andrews-Sewanee, **the fair is open to all Chattanooga area high school students**. There are currently 80 colleges registered and we are hoping to see that number rise a bit in the next month. Scholarships: <u>State-Aid-Summary-Co24.pdf</u> (<u>collegefortn.org</u>) All CCA seniors have already applied for the TNPromise Scholarship.

To qualify for any Federal, State, or College/University aid you will need to complete the 2024-2025 Free Application for Federal Student Aid, FAFSA. Most institutional scholarships require the FAFSA as well. Due to a redesign of the FAFSA form, the 2024-2025 FAFSA will be available sometime in December instead of the usual opening in October. Federal Student Aid has not provided the exact date, so I expect it will be toward the end of December. We will send updates as they are available.
