From the Principal

TNReady Testing: Testing for TCAP and EOCs begins Monday!. Please make a strong effort to have students well rested, on time, and prepared to test during these days. Also, please create some reminders to be sure your student charges their chromebook each night and brings it to school the next day. Daily testing should be completed by lunch, and students will return to regular classes in the afternoon. Please do not ask to dismiss students before noon for appointments. Once we start testing, we cannot disturb the testing environment to call students for dismissal. Therefore, there will be no dismissals from 9:00-12:00 each day of testing.

As we move into warmer weather, please review the CCA dress code with your students. Note that we have one of the most lenient dress codes out there, but we do need to require a certain level of appropriate attire. If in doubt, students should bring a change of clothes.

DRESS CODE – Appropriate dress is required.

Students are expected to dress appropriately at school. At the Center for Creative Arts, the dress code is as follows:

- 1. Cutoffs, beachwear, running shorts, spandex shorts, or mini-skirts are not allowed. Shorts and skirts worn with or without leggings should be no shorter than 4 inches above the knee (front and back). Leggings or jeggings (no holes above the knee) worn as pants must have a top that falls to mid-thigh front and back.
- 2. Shirts must cover cleavage, midriffs/stomachs, and backs. No "off the shoulder" tops
- 3. No pajamas.
- 4. No clothing with mesh or sheer material without proper undergarments.
- 5. Jeans must have NO holes above the knee. Note: for the 24-25 school year, no rips or holes in pants/jeans will be permitted.
- 6. Articles of clothing bearing a symbol, design or emblem that has racial overtones, having indecent or obscene words, slogans or weapon images, representing affiliation with unlawful organizations, advertising the use of drugs, tobacco or alcohol, or causing a disruption of any sort is not to be worn at any time.
- 7. Shoes must be worn at all times no house shoes, flip flops/slides, or bedroom slippers.
- 8. No blankets.
- 9. No personal grooming in public hair, makeup, etc.
- 10. Hooded outerwear is allowed, but hoods should not be worn over the student's head while in the school building.

As college decisions begin to trickle in, I know many of you are thinking about financial aid and scholarships. Here's a quick reference guide to Tennessee Financial Aid & Scholarships: State-Aid-Summary-Co24.pdf (collegefortn.org) All CCA seniors have already applied for the TNPromise Scholarship.

To qualify for any Federal, State, or College/University aid you will need to complete the 2024-2025 Free Application for Federal Student Aid, FAFSA. Most institutional scholarships require the FAFSA as well. Due to a redesign of the FAFSA form, the 2024-2025 FAFSA will be available sometime in December instead of the usual opening in October. Federal Student Aid has not provided the exact date, so I expect it will be toward the end of December. We will send updates as they are available.
