As the Holidays approach and college decisions begin to trickle in, I know many of you are thinking about financial aid and scholarships. Here's a quick reference guide to Tennessee Financial Aid & Scholarships:State-Aid-Summary-Co24.pdf

(collegefortn.org) All CCA seniors have already applied for the TNPromise Scholarship.

To qualify for any Federal, State, or College/University aid you will need to complete the 2024-2025 Free Application for Federal Student Aid, FAFSA. Most institutional scholarships require the FAFSA as well. Due to a redesign of the FAFSA form, the 2024-2025 FAFSA will be available sometime in December instead of the usual opening in October. Federal Student Aid has not provided the exact date, so I expect it will be toward the end of December. We will send updates as they are available.

On January 11, 2024, there will be a required meeting for seniors and their parents to go over senior events and fees, graduation, and financial aid updates and the FAFSA. Federal Student Aid has released some helpful videos that answer many FAFSA questions.
