Academic Success Interventions: There will be a study hall held on Wednesday, September 20, 2023 to assist students with missing work. **Transportation:** To address traffic congestion in the AM, Bus 300 has been added to the CCA route. It will pick up students at 8:00 am at Big Ridge Elementary and drop them off at CCA at 8:25 am.
