**Climbing Team:** The first CCA Climbing Team practice will be held Thursday (9/14) at High Point Climbing and Fitness Riverside (Appling St.) from 5:00-6:30 p.m. New and

returning students will need to turn in a waiver/permission form and purchase a membership, punch pass or day pass to participate.

About the team- the CCA Climbing Team is co-ed and open to all grade levels. No try-out or experience is required. While we do participate in the ICL (interscholastic climbing league) competitions against other schools, the main goal of the team is to foster personal growth and create a positive climbing community. The ICL is run by High Point Climbing and Fitness. The gym requires a membership, punch card or day pass to be purchased in order to participate. **Transportation:** To address traffic congestion in the AM, Bus 300 has been added to the CCA route. It will pick up students at 8:00 am at Big Ridge Elementary and drop them off at CCA at 8:25 am. This replaces Bus 334 which formerly stopped At Big Ridge Elementary. Bus 334 will continue to stop at Big Ridge Rd and Colonial Shores Pool at 7:50 am, Big Ridge Rd. and River Chase Rd. - November, we will not meet for practices (only competitions). The comp calender will be sent out as soon as we have it.
- During the competitions, participants record their top three completed climbs of the evening.
