Seventh Grade Supply List 2018-2019

Each student should have and keep in their lockers:

- a backpack that will fit into a locker (backpacks are not allowed in classrooms; backpacks with wheels usually will not fit into a locker)
- 4 or 5 packs of notebook paper (at least—they may need more mid-year)
- 2 or 3 packs of pencils (teachers do not supply pencils for students)
- 1 **heavy-duty** 1" binder with a pencil pouch (agenda mate will stay in here)
- packet of cap erasers for pencils
- 1 handheld pencil sharpener
- 1 pack of colored pencils
- **Math:**
 - 1 composition notebook
 - 1 packet of graph paper
 - 1 **heavy-duty** 1" binder with a pencil pouch AND 5 pocket tab dividers
- **Science:**
 - 1 to 2 **One subject** spiral notebooks
 - 1 **heavy-duty** 1" binder with a pencil pouch AND 5 pocket tab dividers
 - 1 roll of tape
- **Language Arts/ Reading:**
 - 1 Three subject spiral notebook
 - 1 **heavy-duty** 1" binder with a pencil pouch AND 5 pocket tab dividers
 - 1 package Post-it notes
- **Social Studies:**
 - 4 One subject spiral notebooks or composition books

Each student should bring: (and give to the 1A teacher for sharing please)

- 2 boxes of tissues
- 1 roll of paper towels
- 1 pack index cards (with horizontal lines)
- 1 box of markers
- 1 large package of glue sticks
- 1 large bottle of hand sanitizer
- 1 box of colored pencils

Teachers always appreciate:

- Extra dry erase markers; dry erase board cleaner
- All purpose spray cleaner without bleach or sanitizing wipes
- Extra cap erasers

Students will be given an agenda mate. This is provided by the school and is incredibly important for writing down assignments, due dates, and hall passes. If students lose their agenda mates, they must purchase the replacement (usually about \$5).
