**Eighth Grade Supply List 2018-2019**

**In order to secure a successful start to the year, each student should have:**

Please make sure your student's name is put on all supplies.

- ✓ Backpack (has to fit into locker)
- ✓ Notebook paper – Enough to last the whole year
- ✓ Graph paper – 2 packs
- ✓ Pencils/Erasers-Enough to last the whole year
- ✓ Pens – blue or black
- ✓ Highlighters
- ✓ A box of colored pencils
- ✓ Notebooks – 3-ring binders for 5 academic classes
  - Math – 2” minimum, Composition Book
  - LA –Folder with brads and pockets or 1” binder
  - Foreign Language – 1”

## **Eighth Grade Summer Reading List 2018-2019**
