Sixth Grade Supply List 2018-2019

Each student should have and keep in their lockers

- a backpack that will fit into a locker (backpacks of any kind are not allowed in classrooms; backpacks with wheels usually will not fit into a locker)
- 4 or 5 packs of notebook paper (at least—they may need more mid-year)
- 2 or 3 packs of pencils (teachers do not supply pencils for students)
- (1) 1 1/2" binder with a pencil pouch and a set of dividers to hold agenda mate, homework, announcements, arts information—this is your MAIN BINDER to carry to every class and home every day
- For **Reading/Language Arts**: 2 hardback composition notebooks
- For **Math**: 2 packs of graph paper (4 squares per inch)
- For **Social Studies**: 4 composition notebooks (1 per quarter)
- For **Science**: a pack of highlighters, 2 composition notebooks (1 per semester), 1 roll of tape

Each student should bring (and give to the Language Arts teacher for sharing)

- 2 boxes of tissues and 1 roll of paper towels
- 6 glue sticks
- 1 pack broad-tipped markers OR 1 pack dry erase markers (broad or narrow)
- 1 pack of index cards (3"x5")
- 1 pack of colored pencils

Arts classes

Each art class your student takes will have specific supply needs. It may be a plain black notebook for music or appropriate clothes for musical theatre/dance or a violin for strings. Those specific supply requests will come from the arts teacher at the beginning of school next year. Because there are so many different arts classes, we cannot list the specific arts supplies here.

Teachers always appreciate

- dry erase board cleaner
- bottles of hand sanitizer
- other specific needs for different subjects (check with teacher)

Students will be given

- an agenda mate. This is provided by the school and is incredibly important for writing down assignments, due dates, and hall passes. If students lose their agenda mates, they must purchase a replacement (usually about \$5).
