



Painted Parking Spot Application 2023 - 2024

Requirements to paint your parking spot:

- **Parking Permit:** Students must have a parking permit for the 2023 - 2024 school year with Mr. Flowers. This is open only for student drivers that are Juniors and Seniors.
- **Design Sheet:** Complete and turn in your design sheet by **Monday, September 25 at 4 p.m.**
 - Sketches designed on paper must be turned into Mrs. Scott's mailbox.
 - Sketches designed online should be emailed to **scott_aseneth@hcde.org**
 - All sketches must be approved by the administration.
 - The parking lot spot is for parking your car only (not to be shared with friends).
- **Attend the event:** Students should attend and paint on **Saturday, September 30 @ 10:00 am**
- Check in upon arrival
 - Grab necessary supplies
- Students must clean any spills and discard any unused materials

Materials needed:

- Latex paint-Exterior-Water based (Home Depot, Sherwin-Williams, Lowe's)
 - No oil based paints, reflective paint, spray paints, or fluorescent paints
 - This can take several quarts
 - Brushes, rollers, or sponge to apply paint (4 inch)
 - **See color palette**
 - We will have some paint and limited supplies on site for shared use, but students should bring their own paint and supplies if possible. If you bring your own paint, make sure it is one from our color palette.
- Painter's tape for borders (thicker option)
- Stool or towel to sit on
- Broom to sweep the spot prior to painting. Bringing a leaf blower helps!
- Drop cloth for paint (paint cans), paint stirring sticks, paint can openers, paint trays
- Plastic bucket or containers for water, paint, and brushes

Design Criteria:

- Be free of offensive language or symbolism and double meanings
- Must be school appropriate
- Design must be pre-approved by Administration and the design must reflect what was approved.

Painting Tips:

- Tape the edges of your spot with a 2 inch margin before painting
- Do not paint on the yellow lines, parking lot curbs, or numbers
- Sweep the dirt and pebbles off the spot
- Use chalk to draw out your sketch
- Start painting at the front of your spot out to the end (front bumper to back bumper)...others will be working beside you and you cannot step on their spot
- Consider making a stencil ahead of time for lettering or detailed images
- Bring extra plastic containers (no glass) for water and brushes. Having an extendable paint roller will save you so much time!
- Limit your paint palette, it will take at least 2 quarts of paint to cover the spot if you are using a solid color.

Supplies: Read the materials needed section.

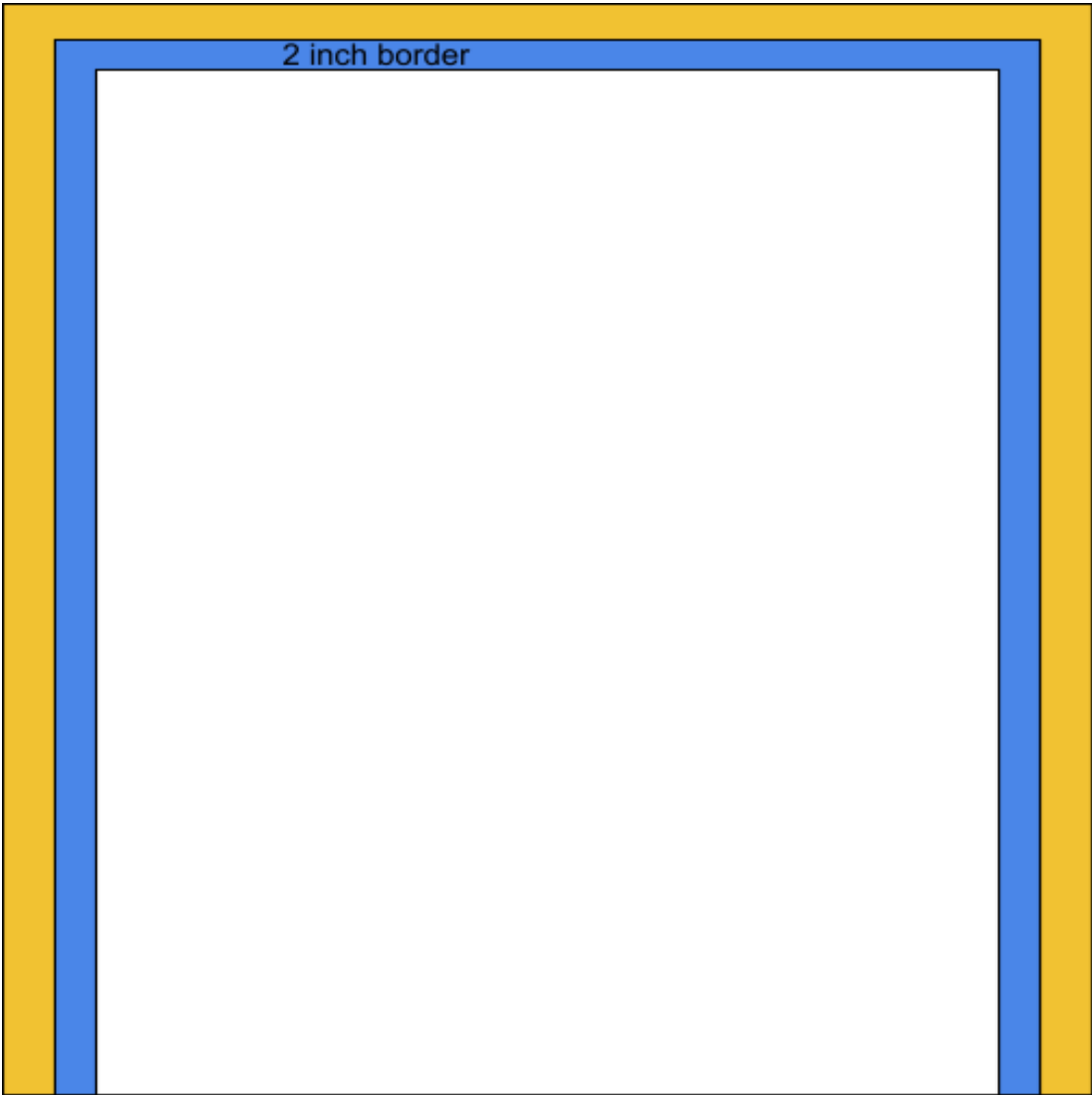
