You may have seen in the news that the school board sent their facilities recommendation to the board, listing converting the Gateway building into a new school for CCA. I anticipate that any move for us won't occur for *at least* two years. I don't have information yet about the design process, but please be assured that we will hold input sessions once we learn more. This will be an exciting time for us as we dream and plan for the most amazing <u>arts</u> facilities for our kids!

For Parents of Juniors: All **Juniors will take the ACT at school on March 21st**. Although teachers have already been including ACT prep in their teaching, all Juniors will start official ACT prep during DS on Monday. For the 3rd quarter, Juniors will have ACT prep four days each week. We will also hold a full-day ACT Boot Camp on Tuesday, March 19th. The school district purchased a new program (Mastery Prep) and has contracted with the company for one boot camp for each school. Additionally, all CCA high school students will have access to the online ACT prep program through the Class Links page on their chromebooks.

As college decisions begin to trickle in, I know many of you are thinking about financial aid and scholarships. Here's a quick reference guide to Tennessee Financial Aid & Scholarships: State-Aid-Summary-Co24.pdf (collegefortn.org) All CCA seniors have already applied for the TNPromise Scholarship.

To qualify for any Federal, State, or College/University aid you will need to complete the 2024-2025 Free Application for Federal Student Aid, FAFSA. Most institutional scholarships require the FAFSA as well. Due to a redesign of the FAFSA form, the 2024-2025 FAFSA will be available sometime in December instead of the usual opening in October. Federal Student Aid has not provided the exact date, so I expect it will be toward the end of December. We will send updates as they are available.
